Christmas Challenge

CHRISTMAS YULE LOG CAKE

For the cake:

- 6 large eggs (separated)
- 150 grams caster sugar
- 50 grams cocoa powder
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 5 teaspoons icing sugar (to decorate)

1. In a large, clean bowl whisk the egg whites until thick & peaking, then, still whisking, sprinkle in 50g of the caster sugar & continue whisking until the whites are holding their peaks but not dry.
2. In another bowl, whisk the egg yolks & the remaining caster sugar until the mixture is moussy, pale and thick. Add the vanilla extract, sieve the cocoa powder over, then fold both in.
3. Lighten the yolk mixture with a couple of dollops of the egg whites, folding them in robustly. Then add the remaining whites in thirds, fold them in carefully to avoid losing the air.
4. Line a Swiss roll tin with baking parchment, leaving a generous overhang at the ends and sides, and folding the parchment into the corners to help the paper stay anchored.
5. Pour in the cake mixture and bake in the oven for 20 minutes. Let the cake cool a little before turning it out onto another piece of baking parchment. If you dust this piece of parchment with a little icing sugar it may help to prevent sticking. Cover loosely with a clean tea towel.

For the icing:

- 175 grams dark chocolate (chopped)
- 250 grams icing sugar
- 225 grams soft butter
- 1 tablespoon vanilla

Preheat oven to 180/ 160 fan forced

6. To make the icing, melt the chocolate – and let it cool.
7. Put the icing sugar into a processor and blitz to remove lumps, add the butter and process until smooth. Add the cooled, melted chocolate and the tablespoon of vanilla extract and pulse again to make a smooth icing.
8. Sit the flat chocolate cake on a large piece of baking parchment. Trim the edges of the Swiss roll. Spread some of the icing thinly over the sponge, going right out to the edges. Start rolling from the long side facing you, taking care to get a tight roll from the beginning, and roll up to the other side. Pressing against the parchment, rather than the tender cake, makes this easier.
9. Cut one or both ends slightly at a gentle angle, reserving the remnants, and place the Swiss roll on a board or long dish. The remnants, along with the trimmed-off bits earlier, are to make a branch or two; you get the effect by placing a piece of cake at an angle to look like a branch coming off the big log.
10. Spread the yule log with the remaining icing, covering the ends as well as any branches. Decorate as you wish.

Rules & Regulations

GENERAL

- Entries must be submitted online via www.alicespringsshow.com.au
- Entries close midnight **18th November 2024**
- Late entries will **NOT** be accepted
- Entries must be delivered to the Showgrounds **Thursday 21st November 2024 between 4:30pm - 6:00pm**
- Entries to be collected **Sunday 24th November 2024 between 9am - 11am**
- Entries are **FREE**
- No prize money is awarded
- Participation prize cards are not issued to every entry
- 1st 2nd 3rd prize cards are not issued to every entry
- Entries are identified for judging and display solely by entry number. Any other form of identification will be removed by the steward/s (except Art and Hobbies)
- Entries from previous years/shows are not eligible to enter again unless a 50% change has occurred.
- Central Australian Show Society does not take any responsibility for damaged, lost, stolen or misplaced items or goods
- All Christmas Show sections and classes must follow the same rules and regulations at the annual Alice Springs Show

If the entrant does not follow the above outlined rules and regulations, they may be subject to disqualification

ART

- Senior entries open to students and amateur artists. NO PROFESSIONALS. Classes will not be separated by age
- No individual entry to exceed **50cm** in any of its dimensions
- Senior entries may be framed or mounted and must have wire attached
- Senior entries will be limited to 2 pieces per person, per class and juniors are restricted to one entry per person per class
- Junior entries cannot be framed due to display space
- Late entries will not be accepted
- Paint by Numbers NOT accepted
- Competitors name, address and class of entry must be clearly printed on the back of each piece of art
- All drawings and paintings must be mounted on stiff cardboard for hanging

COOKING

- Juniors may enter in Senior Classes
- All sponsors may enter their section
- Preserves should be labelled with the name of preserves and date of making as well as the entry number.
- Jar sizes - for jams and preserves approx. **250ml**. Lids should be easily removed
- All food items need to be covered when bringing out to the showgrounds
- All items to be displayed on light boards, thick covered boards or plates. Please ensure all boards/ plates are labelled on the bottom.
- The steward/s may re-plate entries should the presentation impact on space limitations
- Highly perishable exhibits may be removed at any time deemed necessary by the steward/s

CRAFT

- Entries from previous years are not eligible to be entered again
- No work may be entered in more than one class
- The right is reserved for the steward/s or judge/s to transfer any work to the correct class or section at their discretion
- No article will be accepted for display only
- Exhibits must be solely the work of the individual
- Small entries not to exceed **30cm** in any of its dimensions
- Christmas decorations, patchwork & stockings are not to exceed **70cms** in any of its dimensions
- Late entries will not be accepted
- Please observe the "**do not touch**" signs within the display areas

HOBBIES

- Juniors may enter classes in Senior sections
- The steward/s and or judge/s reserve the right to transfer any exhibit to a more appropriate class or division
- All exhibits must be marked with competitors name, concealed where possible
- No exhibits may be collected prior to the advertised times unless under exceptional circumstances where consultation with the steward/s will be necessary
- All entries should not exceed the maximum of **40cm** wide, **40cm** long, **40cm** high
- Late entries might only be accepted for display, if arranged with the steward/s
- No items to be advertised for sale

HORTICULTURE

- The steward/s will subdivide classes for cut flowers should the number of entries make this desirable
- All entries must include **50% natural materials** unless otherwise stated in the schedule
- In arrangement sections, all materials must be **FRESH** but need not be locally grown, unless otherwise stated in the schedule
- Artificial materials may be used where stated including silver, gold, & red spray paint, artificial snow, baubles

PHOTOGRAPHY

- All photos must be mounted on black card
- Up to 8 photos may be submitted per class, per entrant
- A photo can only be entered in one class at the time
- Photos previously exhibited at the Alice Springs Show are not eligible for entry
- The longest side of the photo must not exceed **40cm**. For panorama class photos, the long side of the photo must not exceed **60cm** and must be at least twice the length of the shorter side
